Open Education is an umbrella term or movement with many dimensions that share a common viewpoint “everyone should have the freedom to use, customize, improve and redistribute educational resources without constraint” (Cape Town Open Education Declaration, 2012). Openness comes in many forms and encompasses a number of interrelated practices, terms and approaches in the higher education context (Costello, Huijser, Marshall, 2019). These include OER underpinned by Creative Commons licensing and open teaching and learning practices. While Open Education has been a feature of educational research and practice for almost 30 years, its adoption has been

In 2030, OER repositories will have extended their mission from the role of OER provisioners to serving as community hubs. Strong, human networks of educators and trainers as well as learners will collaborate with each other on quality development, development of 'open educator skills' and exchange training and learning experiences.
